Home Economics & Horticulture Judging and Awards

Regulations for Open or Youth Divisions

Wednesday - Entry Day

All entries must be made between 10:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.

1. All judging and exhibits will be done on a group basis.

2. All Exhibit Classes Open, and Youth Exhibitors for Home Economics & Horticulture will be Ribbon & Premium.

Open Division-Adults, Ribbons Only.

Youth Division. Ribbons and Premiums: Blue - \$1.00; Red-\$.75; White-\$.50

3. Labeling for display:

A. Each article must be labeled with an official fair entry tag.

B. Note to Home Economics and Educational Exhibitors:

1. On clothing - safety pin entry tag inside back of neck of dresses, coats, blouses, etc.

2. On food preservation, label on opposite brand side of jar 1/2" from bottom.

3. On Home Educational Exhibits and Home Furnishings - label on underside of article.

4. On food preparation - label on upper edge of plate.

5. On fancy work - safety pin on top side of hem.

C. **Important:** Care should be taken to make your own label for the bottom of pajamas, second pillow case, dress belts, etc.

4. Exhibiting:

All foods need to be placed on paper plates or cardboard mats, and then placed in **plastic** bags, except vegetables and fruits. It is recommended that all clothing and textile articles be placed in plastic bags.

5. All entries are to remain on exhibit through Friday, (except by permission of Department Superintendent).

6. All articles and entries should be picked up between 6:00 & 7:00 p.m.

No superintendent will be responsible for any articles left after 7:00 p.m. All entries left after 7:00 p.m. will be your responsibility.

Note: All projects must be of fair quality, subject to the discretion of the Superintendent.
