2. An exhibitor will be limited to two (2) premiums (animals) per class.  
Premium in each class: Cows: 1st - \$18.00; 2nd - \$14.00; 3rd - \$10.00  
Heifers: 1st - \$14.00; 2nd - \$10.00; 3rd - \$8.00  
Youth points 30 - 20 - 10
3. Check-in time: Thursday 9:00 a.m.
4. Check-out time: Saturday
5. Awards to be given for Premier Exhibitors if sponsored.

## Division A - Dairy Feeder Steers

**Friday - Show following Swine Show**

1. All animals must be entered before show.
2. Check-in time: Thursday 9:00 a.m.
3. All Feeder Steers must have a tag to identify and match each animal from the first weigh-in.
4. Dairy Feeder Steers cannot have horns.
5. Participants must be 8 years old as of First Day of Fair.
6. Participants may weigh-in two Dairy Feeder Steers.
7. Only one Dairy Feeder is allowed to be sold.
7. Participants may only sell one bovine species at the fair.  
(EX: They may not sell a Dairy Feeder and a Beef Steer.)
8. For the Dairy Feeder program, we require each participant to complete a project record/notebook of their fair animal.  
Ribbons will be awarded for the Best of Show.  
Notebook - 1st year participants  
Notebook - 2nd year participants  
Notebook - 3rd year participants
9. In order to sell, Dairy Feeder Steers must meet the minimum weight requirement of 300 pounds.
