4. All purebred animals must have registration papers at time of show.
5. All market hogs will be divided by weight.
6. Check-in time: Thursday 9:00 a.m. Weigh-in and ultrasounds to follow.
7. Check-out time: Saturday after sale.
8. No razorback or pot belly pigs allowed.
9. Gilts entered in the market hog class are ineligible to compete in the breeding classes.

10. All under/over weight animals must be removed by 8:00 a.m. Saturday.
 11. All swine exhibitors are allowed one pen. Extra animals may be required to show off trailers.

5. Any individual showing sheep must be able to physically control his/her animals while in the show ring.
6. Non-aggressive Rams are permitted.
- 7. All sheep must have a scrapie tag, and a health certificate with a veterinarian's signature.**
8. Pens will be assigned by the sheep and goat superintendents.
 NO EXCEPTIONS.
9. Market sheep must have a 60lb. minimum weight.
10. Sheep trophies, prizes & Shepherd Award will be awarded during the awards ceremony on Saturday.

11. All pens must be cleaned before leaving.
