

## Division E - Goats

**Meat Goats: Thursday - Show at 4:00 p.m.**

**Dairy Goats: Friday - Show at 6:00 p.m.**

**New this year:** Meat Goat and Dairy Goat shows are on different days. Make sure you determine your class by the type of goat you are showing. There are differences in class descriptions and numbers. **LOOK CLOSELY.** Open classes will be divided into subdivisions: *Registered* (must have registration papers and easy-to-read tattoos) and *Crossbred Influenced*. Classes and rules are subject to change due to the new changes/classes.

1. All animals must be owned by the exhibitor, have a Scrapie tag, health papers, and registration papers (if applicable).
2. General rules and regulations as stated on previous pages.
3. All goat awards, except Shepherd award, will be handed out during the goat show. There will only be one senior Shepherd and one Junior Shepherd awarded. Meat and Dairy youth exhibitors will compete for the same awards. Kiddies may only show in one goat Kiddie class (Meat or Dairy).
4. Market goats can only be shown in the Market Class.
5. Goats may be led by a rope and/or halter; no spike halters.
6. **Check-in time:** Wednesday at 8:00 a.m. Pens will be assigned upon arrival.
7. **Check-out time:** Saturday after market sale.
8. **All pens must be cleaned before leaving.**
9. Basic date in figuring age is date of show.
10. Junior Points: 25 - 15 - 10
11. Open Class \$7.50, \$4.50, \$3.00
11. Exhibitors must be neatly and properly dressed (Dairy preferably in white) when in the show ring.

NOTE: Classes 13-21 are ribbon-only classes. Entry fee is not required but must be entered on entry form. Animals must have been shown in classes 1-12 in order to show in these classes. **There is no charge for showmanship, herdmanship, or champion classes.**

  12. Wether under one (1) year, NOT market animals
  13. Dam and Daughter
  14. Produce of Dam: (2 does, produce of 1 dam)
  15. Breeder's Trio: (3 does, bred and raised on same farm)
  16. Best of Herd: (4 does, owned by exhibitor; do not have to be in milk for meat, but they must be in milk for dairy.)
  17. Best Pair of Does: (2 does, any age, must have been shown in respective classes)
  18. Senior Get of Sire: (3 does, get of 1 sire)
  19. Junior Get of Sire: (3 junior does, get of 1 sire, dry yearling or younger)
  20. Exhibitor's Flock of Goats: (1 aged doe, 1 yearling doe, 1 kid doe, 1 billy under 1)
  21. Herdsman Special: (5 does of same breed, 2 from junior division and 3 from senior division. All different classes. Must be bred and owned by exhibitor)
  22. Market Goats, YOUTH only; must be weighed in; minimum weight to sell is 40 lbs. Ideal weight for market goats is 50 - 70 lbs.
