 20. Herdsman Special: (5 does of same breed, 2 from junior division and 3 from senior division. All different classes. Must be bred and owned by exhibitor)

This year's theme for the goat and sheep barn is "#Doityourway - decorate your pens and dress your sheep / goats in your own unique style. Have and express yourself in #yourownway.

NO glitter, paint, glue, etc. The safety of animals is our first priority. Costumes will be at the discretion of the division superintendents.

1. All animals must be owned by exhibitor, cooped and entered before the show.
2. General rules and regulations as stated on previous pages.
3. All animals must be entered before the show.
4. **Check in time:** Wednesday at 8:00 a.m.
5. **Check out time:** Saturday after the market sale.
6. Show will be open to all Bantam chickens, large chickens, Bantam ducks, standard ducks and geese or any specialty fowl.
7. Animals may be cooped, but may be reassigned at the superintendent's discretion.
8. Birds showing any signs of sickness will be removed and barred from the show.
9. Only the judge, owner and show official will be allowed to handle the birds. Poultry and waterfowl will be shown by breed with a class for mixed breed.
10. One entry per class, per breed, per color. No limit on number of breeds.
11. Youth exhibitors may be required to carry animal to Poultry Judge, at the judge's request.
12. Youth exhibitors may only enter the youth show.
13. All poultry and waterfowl must stay in its assigned barn.
14. Youth Points 3-2-1
15. Open Class \$1.25, \$1.00, \$0.75
